Clover Hill's STOP DROP GO

To enhance the safety of your children, the school's Active Safe Travel committee in conjunction with school staff has adopted the 'Look Out' Program. **During COVID restrictions, this is our preferred method for dropping off and picking up your children each day.** Supervision will be in the afternoon only.

Purpose

To manage the two-minute drop off /pick up loading zone. These zones are valuable tools for parents to pick up and deliver their children quickly and safely. They are designed for motorists who simply want to drop and go.

Who needs to be involved?

Everyone, it is a united effort. Co-operation by all who use the zone is paramount. The only way the Program can work is if the zone is left free of parked vehicles.

Using the loading zone correctly:

Please:

- Park in the designated area
- Remain in your car
- Make sure your children know to be ready
- When car spaces become empty, move forward in the line when it is safe to do so
- Plan your trip to avoid arrival at peak times
- Pick up children via kerbside doors

Remember:

- It is a 2-minute zone
- If your children are not loaded within two minutes – drive out of the zone
- Find a parking space elsewhere, drive off and re-join the back of the queue
- Be considerate and do not ~~overstay~~ overstay your time in the loading zone
- Display family name on front passenger sun visor.

We want you to involve your children – ask them to:

- Watch for their car
- Be ready with their bag in hand
- Listen for their name to be called
- Load their bag in the car quickly

Parking around schools is limited. Your school is doing everything reasonable to ensure your children remainsafe.

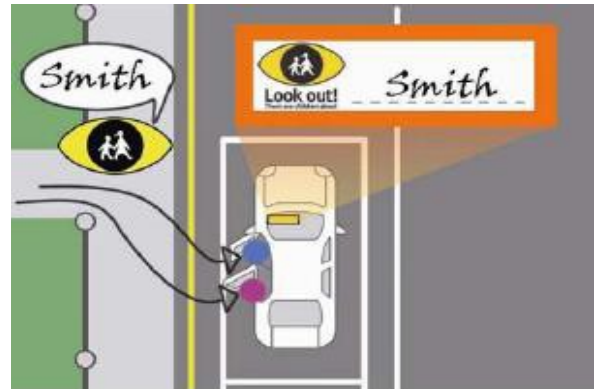
Signs will be delivered to your children via the class teacher.

your family name tag on the dash or sun visor.



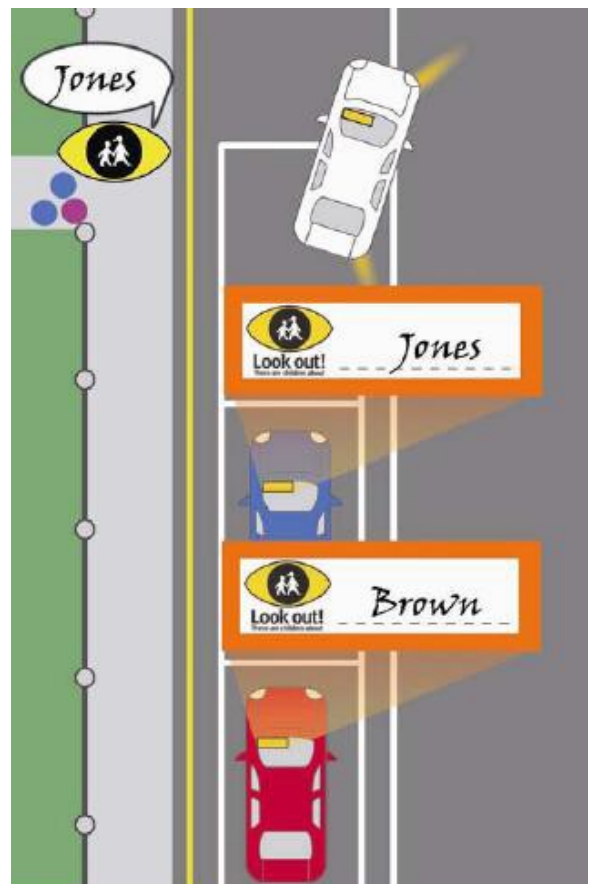
Step Four - Load

delay.



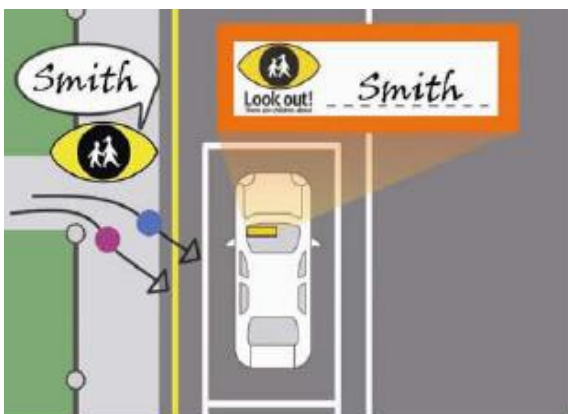
Step Two - Wait
