

Rationale

The Clover Hill State School P&C has determined that our school is a full uniform school. The school uniform is regarded by the school community as being important in its role in encouraging a sense of identity and pride; strengthening school community cohesion; enhancing student safety, health and wellbeing and preparing students for the expectations of some workplaces. The school uniform of Clover Hill State School is designed to give students a sense of purpose that lends itself to the process of education. The wearing of school uniform also ensures that outsiders who wish to intrude into our school grounds are readily identifiable.

The uniform has been designed with elements of comfort, climate, cost, efficiency, social equity and activity considered. **Clover Hill State School Uniform Expectations**

APPEARANCE

- Children are expected to come to school each day presented neatly and tidily in correct school uniform.
- Safety requirements necessitate the wearing of closed shoes/sneakers. Also for safety reasons, if hair touches the collar then it must be tied up with either a blue, green or black hair-tie.
- A watch and one pair of earrings (sleepers or studs) are the only jewellery items permitted to be worn to school. No other jewellery is acceptable, except for cultural or religious necklaces which can be worn concealed beneath the blouse or shirt as long as the Principal's written approval has been given. Medical bracelets or necklaces are exempt from this policy.
- Children must wear a hat in the playground or move to an under covered area during play time.
- Nail polish and make-up is not be worn to school.
- Hairstyles must be neat, clean and tidy, and of natural toning and style. 'Tracks' are not considered to be a natural style and, therefore, are not allowed at school.

Procedure for Addressing Dress Code Breaches

- 1. If a student is not adhering to the school dress code, teachers will send the student to the office where one of our office staff will record the breach on ID attend system and students will receive a uniform slip. Where possible the office staff will also arrange for the student to exchange their inappropriate clothing item for one that is more appropriate from our store of second-hand uniforms.
- Fortnightly reports of breaches will be run by the office staff and students who have had 3 or more breaches in that period will have an email sent to their parents requesting compliance to the school's dress code (sample below).
- 3. If a student persists in not wearing the appropriate uniform or hair/dress requirements then the sector deputy will contact parents to explain the inappropriate nature of the dress and offer assistance to help parents to adhere to the policy, i.e. access to second-hand clothing store. Parents should be informed that wearing school uniform with pride is a Clover Hill State School PBL expectation and; therefore, repeated breaches of the school uniform expectations may result in a behaviour consequence being given.
- 4. At this stage DP may give a consequence for breaches or agree to continue monitoring dress code adherence. N.B. Students may not be able to attend or participate in certain events where uniform is required, such as; school excursions, interschool events, student leadership selection process, etc.

When resolving matters concerning the student dress code, flexibility and common sense should prevail, especially in relation to the following circumstances:

- Families experiencing economic hardship should be offered special arrangements, or an extended period of time, to purchase new items of dress (at the discretion of the Principal).
 Students with physical impairments should be permitted considerable flexibility in the interpretation of the dress code.
- Objections raised on any reasonable grounds will be considered by the principal.

Dear Parent / Caregiver

I am writing to request your support in relation to adherence to our student dress code. It has been identified that your child has been in breach of the Clover Hill State School Student Dress Code on several occasions recently.

Where families are experiencing financial difficulties in purchasing uniform items, we encourage parents to contact the school administration so that we can make arrangements to support dress code adherence. We also have a second-hand clothing pool which students can borrow to wear for the day. All uniforms are clean and in good repair.

If, for any reason, you are unable to address the breaches in the Clover Hill State School Student Dress Code, I would request that you contact your child's sector Deputy Principal.
